
Gibson County Board of Commissioners
Regular Session
November 5, 2008

The Gibson County Board of Commissioners met in regular session on November 5, 2008, at 9 AM in the North Annex Meeting Room.

The meeting was brought to order with all present standing and reciting the Pledge of Allegiance.

Approval of Minutes: The minutes of the previous meeting, October 20, 2008, were approved with a motion by Whitehead seconded by Townsend and passed 3-0.

Claims: The following claims were presented for approval: Payroll, 10/24, \$277,349.21 and 11/7, \$ 276,934.86; Sheriff, \$39,467.10; Highway, \$26,521.71; County General, \$80,046.20. All claims were approved with a motion by Whitehead seconded by Townsend and passed 3-0.

Medical Leave: Medical leave was requested for an employee of the Superior Court. This was approved with a motion by Townsend seconded by Whitehead and passed 3-0.

Dept. Reports: Weights & Measures: Gary Dawson gave the monthly report.

Safety: Ken Greubel reported there had been a couple incidents reported and are now under investigation at this time.

Highway: Jerry Heldt gave the monthly report and reported that a truck had broken the surface of Bridge 285 which is on CR 900E, this is a wooden structure. He had gotten quotes for the repair of the bridge and after reviewing the quotes recommended that E&H Bridge, \$32,213.00 for a steel structure and over all the lowest quote for all cost. This recommendation was accepted with a motion by Whitehead seconded by Townsend and passed 3-0.

Extension Office: Cathy Boerste announced the Annual Meeting to be held in the cafeteria of Princeton Community High School.

Sheriff: Allen Harmon asked that a 40 MPH speed limit be placed on the new section of County Road 550E that will be needed to accommodate the I 69 route. This new part of 550E will be built west of I 69 and run from County Road 1050S to County Road 900S. This was approved with a motion by Townsend seconded by Whitehead and passed 3-0. He reported that the new radio console is in and working and that the roof repair on the jail should be completed by the end of the week.

Jerry Stilwell stated that there is a need to schedule an executive session to discuss a pending grievance. This was scheduled for Tuesday, November 18, 2008, at 10 AM. He also reported that Mayor Hurst of Princeton has asked if the County could consider giving the old Highway garage sight to the city. After discussion a motion to give the property to the City of Princeton was made by Whitehead seconded by Townsend and passed 3-0.

Having no further business a motion to adjourn was made by Townsend seconded by Whitehead and passed 3-0.
