The Gibson County Board of Commissioners met on December 21, 2010, at 6:00 PM in the North Annex Meeting Room.

The meeting was called to order with all present standing and reciting the Pledge of Allegiance.

Claims: The following claims were submitted for approval: Payroll, 12/17/2010, \$304,536.63; County General, \$100,489.02; Courts, \$9,328.02; Highway, \$120,608.32; Sheriff, \$46,792.01. These claims were approved with a motion by Bledsoe seconded by Whitehead and passed 3-0.

Old Business: Bids for the Highway Department: Jerry Heldt presented the recommendations from the bids opened at the previous meeting of December 7, 2010. The recommendations were awarded with a motion by Bledsoe seconded by Whitehead and passed 3-0.


Quotes for Aerial Photography: Michael Stevenson, Surveyor and John Howe, GIS Director, reviewed quotes received to do new aerial photography for the GIS mapping. Howe explained that the quotes are based on Posey County sharing this project with us. Gibson County based on mileage is approximately 54% of the project. Based on this fact Gibson County's cost will be \$54,265. Posey County had not made a final decision at this time but stated Aerial Services Inc was the probable choice. A motion to accept the quote from Aerial Services Inc. at the for mentioned cost was made by Bledsoe seconded by Whitehead and passed 3-0.


Steve Bottoms express a concern on the newly paved section of CR 1150. He stated the road was great but at the mine crossing there was at least four inches of mud on the road. Heldt stated that he had received calls on this and it has been cleaned by the mining company and they will keep a watch to make sure this problem doesn't happen again.

New Business: Contract for newly elected Sheriff: After reviewing the contract a motion to approve based on acceptance by the County Council was made by Whitehead seconded by Bledsoe and passed 3-0.


