Purpose of the Meeting: Open Monetary Bids from prospective IT Providers

1. Advanced Network - \$25,250/month; technical alternative \$15,500/month; Backup solution one-time fee of \$28,000; Option Cloud replica \$10,000; Annual is \$8,000 for Backup and \$10,000 for the option.
2. North Main Systems - \$120,000 Annually
3. Automated Office Solutions - \$130,194 Annually
4. Kemper Technology Consultants - \$10,500/Monthly Service Fee
5. PC Quest - \$128,040 Annually
6. Parish Consulting Service - \$86,800 Annually
