February 2, 2010

The Gibson County Commissioners met in regular session on February 2, 2010 at 8:30 AM in the North Annex.

The meeting was called to order with all present, standing and reciting the Pledge of Allegiance

A motion was made by Bledsoe and seconded by Whitehead to approve the minutes of the January 10, 2010 meeting. Motion passed 3-0. Claims in the amounts of \$279,690.25- Payroll, for 1/29/10, \$234,312.59-Hwy/Bridges, \$51,633.72-Sheriff, \$513,144.84-Co General, and \$16,809.25-Courts, were approved with a motion by Whitehead and a second by Bledsoe. All voted aye.

Department reports were given by Barb Schenks-Veterans Service, Kanda Walden – Health Dept, Dan Alvey – EMS, Terry Hedges-EMA, Allen Harmon – Sheriff and Jerry Heldt – Hwy.

Dan Alvey told the Commissioners that the new ambulance is in. He also asked for a six week leave for an employee of the EMS. A motion to grant this was made by Bledsoe and seconded by Whitehead. Motion passed 3-0.

Terry Hedges stated that he will have a County Emergency Plan available for the next Commissioner’s meeting.

Jerry Heldt stated that the new equipment will be delivered in March.

Allen Harmon discussed the new stop signs at Pilot on Hwy 41S. A motion to approve two stop signs at Pilot east and three stop signs at Pilot west was made by Whitehead and seconded by Bledsoe, with the provision of any legalities being taken care of. All voted aye.

Motion to recess the regular meeting and convene the Finance Committee meeting was made by Whitehead and seconded by Bledsoe. Motion passed 3-0. Jim Kolb, the Gibson County Treasurer, read the minutes from last year’s meeting. The voided warrants were accepted, and Gerald Bledsoe was reelected as Finance Committee Chairman. Motion to adjourn this meeting was made by Townsend and seconded by Bledsoe. All voted aye.




Motion to reconvene the Commissioner’s meeting was made by Bledsoe and seconded by Whitehead. Motion passed 3-0.



A six weeks medical leave was granted for an employee of the Clerk’s office with a motion by Whitehead and a second by Bledsoe. Motion passed 3-0.

A citizen spoke of concern for safety at the intersection of Tichenor Road and Hwy 64W. Hwy Supervisor, Jerry Heldt, stated that this would probably be an INDOT issue and that he would get in touch with them.

Motion to adjourn was made by Bledsoe and seconded by Whitehead. All voted aye
