The Gibson County Board of Commissioners met in regular session on May 18, 2010, at 6:00 PM in the North Annex Meeting Room.

The meeting was called to order with all present standing and reciting the Pledge of Allegiance.

Claims: The following claims were submitted for approval: Payroll, 5/21/10, \$276,248.24; County General, \$224,285.62; Courts, \$793.86; Highway, \$117,353.51; Sheriff, \$29,712.37. The claims were approved with a motion by Bledsoe seconded by Whitehead and passed 3-0.

Old Business: Personnel Handbook Revision: The revision was for the new "sick leave bank" for the employees. This was approved with a motion by Whitehead seconded by Bledsoe and passed 3-0.

Windsor Property Lien: Windsor Plastics has received a grant, through the county, for equipment and this agreement allows the County to hold a security agreement on the equipment to protect the County. A motion to approve this agreement was made by Whitehead seconded by Bledsoe and passed 3-0.

New Business: Deed Restrictions on Closed landfills: The Department of Environmental Management request that the County put restriction on the deed to the old landfills concerning any disturbance to the ground. This is to be recorded in the Recorder's office. A motion to do so was made by Bledsoe seconded by Whitehead and passed 3-0.

Request to Use Court House Area for Farmers Market: A request from Richard Ritter, Gibson County Farmers Market Association, to be allowed to use the parking lot on the west side of the Courthouse on Saturdays from June 19 through Labor Day Weekend from 9 AM to 1 PM for the market. They have purchased insurance as in years past. This was approved with a motion by Bledsoe seconded by Whitehead and passed 3-0.


EMS: Dan Alvey asked for approval of write offs for March, \$50,901.36 and April, \$36,747.38. These were approved with a motion by Bledsoe seconded by Whitehead and passed 3-0.

Sheriff: Allen Harmon presented a request for medical leave for an employee. This was approved with a motion by Bledsoe seconded by Whitehead and passed 3-0.

Highway: Jerry Heldt gave a report on rock usage due to the winter weather and also stated the bridge work on CR 350 S is complete and the speed limit can now be set. The speed limit recommended by the Sheriff is 40 MPH. A motion to approve the recommended limit was made by Bledsoe seconded by Whitehead and passed 3-0.

Treasurer Jim Kolb announced that 97.1% of the Spring property taxes have been collected.

Having no further business a motion to adjourn was made by Bledsoe seconded by Whitehead and passed 3-0.


