Special Session
January 31, 2012

The Gibson County Board of Commissioners met on January 31, 2012, at 6:30 PM at the North Annex Meeting Room.

Members Present: Gerald Bledsoe, President, Alan Douglas, VP, Bob Townsend, Jim McDonald, County Attorney, Kay Vore, Administrative Assistant, and C.T. Montgomery, County Auditor.

The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was recited and led by Gerald Bledsoe.

Gerald Bledsoe informed all in attendance that the purpose of the special session was to award the bid for Bridge #503 (Brumfield overpass) and hear group insurance proposals from five insurance companies for salaried county employees.

Gerald Bledsoe asked County Engineer John Umpleby for a recommendation on which bid for bridge #503 that we should accept. John recommended the low bid from Ragle, Inc. for \$773,312.93 and stated the work is to start on March 12, 2012. Alan Douglas made a motion to accept the bid. Bob Townsend seconded the motion and the motion passed 3-0.


Five representatives from different insurance groups made proposals for the Gibson County self-funded salaried employee's health insurance.

Representatives included;



Representatives were informed that the commissioners will be calling them in the next week and make an announcement at the next scheduled meeting February 7, 2012 on which proposal they will be accepting.


Alan Douglas made a motion to adjourn and was seconded by Gerald Bledsoe. The motion passed 3-0.




