The Gibson County Board of Commissioners met in Special Session, Tuesday, December 11, 2012, at 1:30 PM at the Annex North Meeting Room.

Members Present: Alan Douglas, VP, Bob Townsend, Commissioner, Jim McDonald, County Attorney and C.T. Montgomery, Auditor. Kay Vore, Administrative Assistant and Gerald Bledsoe were absent.

Alan Douglas opened the meeting by leading everyone in the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag.

Alan Douglas informed everyone that this special session was to open bids for two tandem axle highway dump trucks and one tractor.

Jim McDonald opened the bids and read them aloud.

Bids Received;

Trucks:

Peterbuilt of Evansville bid for two trucks at a total of \$248,706.00

Wayne Supply bid for two trucks \$164,671.90 per truck (\$329,343.80)

Freightliner-Western Star bid for two trucks was \$119,145.44 per truck (\$238,290.88).

Sternberg International Bid 1 was \$252,253.88 for two trucks and Bid 2 was \$253,147.62 for two trucks.

R&H Truck and Trailer Sales Bid for two trucks was \$324,358.00.

Tractor:


Wayne Supply bid \$121,100.00 for a Challenger Tractor. They also supplied four other alternate bids on other equipment trade-ins and different combinations.


Bob Townsend made a motion to adjourn and was seconded by Alan Douglas. Motion passed 2-0.
