
Gibson County Board of Commissioners
Regular Session
November 19, 2013

The Gibson County Board of Commissioners met on November 19, 2013, at 6:30 PM at the North Annex Meeting Room.

Members Present: President Gerald Bledsoe, Vice-President Alan Douglas, Commissioner Stephen E. Bottoms, Administrative Assistant Kay Vore, County Attorney Jim McDonald, and Marilyn Mason, 1st Deputy

The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag and Welcome was recited and led by President Bledsoe.

Minutes: The minutes from November 5th, 2013 meeting were read and approved through a motion by Commissioner Douglas and seconded by Commissioner Bottoms. Motion carried 3-0.

Claims:

Commissioner Douglas made a motion to approve the claims and was seconded by Commissioner Bottoms. Motion carried 3-0.

Department Reports:

Old Business:

EMS Director, Dan Alvey, presented his monthly report for October. He asked the Commissioners for permission to write off \$72,242.10 for October. Commissioner Bottoms made a motion to approve the write offs for October, seconded by Commissioner Douglas. Motion carried 3-0. Director Alvey informed the Commissioners that the County Council has approved the purchase of 4 power stretchers.

Highway Superintendent, Jerry Heldt, stated that he had gone through the specs of the Freightliner bid for two single axle dump trucks. He recommended that the Commissioners accept the bid. Commissioner Bottoms made a motion to accept the bid of \$216,510 from Freightliner, seconded by Commissioner Douglas. Motion carried 3-0.

Commissioner Bottoms stated that he would like to table the Elevator Contracts until next month for further review.

Speed Limit Request for CR 1200 E from CR 450 S to 850 S - Sheriff's Captain, Tim Bottoms, presented his report on the study of a speed limit for CR 1200E from CR 450S to 850S. A recommendation of 45mph was suggested. Commissioner Douglas made a motion for the posting of a 45mph speed limit on CR 1200E from CR 450S to 850S, seconded by Commissioner Bottoms. Motion carried 3-0.

County Attorney, Jim McDonald, told the Commissioners that the City of Princeton has executed their option of purchase of the City Parking Lot. Payment will be made by wire transfer. After the deed is signed, the money will be transferred. Commissioner Douglas made a motion to sign the deed, seconded by Commissioner Bottoms. Motion carried 3-0.

New Business:

Dan Rininger, with Commonwealth Engineers, addressed the Commissioners with some information concerning the upcoming changes around I69, in the Gibson County area.

Commissioner Bottoms addressed the Commissioners about some projects that he is working on for the I69 area of the County.

Commissioner Bledsoe stated that he went to look at Cecil Allen's property and the electrical was not marked. Mr. Allen stated that he would let the Commissioner's know when that is done, but he doesn't think it will be before Spring.

Cecil Allen stated that there is debris along the curb of 350 W that needs to be removed. Commissioner Douglas told Highway Superintendent, Jerry Heldt, to check out the situation and notify the individual that the items need to be moved within two weeks.

With no further business, Commissioner Douglas adjourned the meeting, seconded by Commissioner Bledsoe. Motion carried 3-0.
