

ORDINANCE 2012-3

BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF GIBSON COUNTY

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING  
COUNTY COMMISSIONER DISTRICTS**

WHEREAS, I.C. 36-2-2-4(a) requires the County Executive to divide the County into three (3) commissioner districts that are composed of contiguous territory, are reasonably compact, do not cross precinct boundary lines and do not divide townships unless a division is clearly necessary to accomplish the districting under the above statute.

WHEREAS, after consideration Gibson County, through its Board of County Commissioners, has determined that the division of the County into three (3) districts as hereinafter provided is proper.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County Commissioners of Gibson County, Indiana, as follows:

That Gibson County be divided into three (3) Commissioner districts as follows:

- (a) District 1 shall consist of Patoka Township;
- (b) District 2 shall consist of Barton, Center, Columbia Washington and White River Townships;
- (c) District 3 shall consist of Johnson, Montgomery, Union and Wabash Townships.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication.
