Regular Session
February 10, 2015

The Gibson County Council met in Regular Session on February 10, 2015, at 9:00 AM at the North Annex Meeting Room.

Members Present: Vice-President Derek McGraw, Councilman Craig Pflug, William McConnell, George Ankenbrand, Dan Beard, Jay Riley and Sherri Smith, Gibson County Auditor.

Members Absent: President Jeremy Overton

The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was recited and led by Vice President McGraw.

Approval of Minutes

January 13th, 2015 Regular Session Minutes – Councilman Pflug made a motion to approve the minutes from the January 13th, 2015 Regular Council Meeting with the correction of Jay Sparks to Jay Riley as the County Council’s appointment to the Community Corrections Board and Derek Ankenbrand to Derek McGraw, seconded by Councilman McConnell. Motion carried 6-0.

Department Reports

Commissioner Douglas discussed Heavy Equipment Operator for Highway Department - The Commissioners did not choose to transfer a portion of the Stone and Gravel money in the Highway Budget to pay the salary of a Heavy Equipment Operator, as the Council had suggested.

Commissioner Bledsoe discussed Highway Fund – Councilman Beard made a motion to advertise an Additional of \$200,000 for Stone and Gravel in the Highway Fund, seconded by Councilman Pflug. Motion carried 6-0.

Old Business

- Health Ordinance 2015-01 – Councilman Ankenbrand made a motion to approve Health Department Ordinance # 2015-01 to increase fees, seconded by Councilman McConnell. Motion carried 6-0.
- Ambulance Quotes – Quotes for the ambulance were not available and was tabled until the next meeting.

- Additional Appropriation for Prosecutor's request for Health Insurance has been advertised. Councilman Ankenbrand made a motion to approve the request for an additional for Health Insurance in the Prosecutor's Budget, seconded by Councilman Pflug. Motion carried 6-0.


New Business

- John Howe Wage Overpayment in 2013 – Councilman Beard made a motion to allow an individual employee to repay a debt to the County of \$990.75 within a period of two years, providing that if he leaves employment of the County before the debt is paid, the remainder of the debt will be paid within 30 days, seconded by Councilman McConnell. Motion carried 6-0.
- Sheriff Department -Debbie Borchelt requests replacement of Correction Officer. Consensus of the Council was given to the Sheriff's Department to replace a full time Corrections Officer.
- Amended EDIT Plan for 2015-16 – Councilman Pflug made a motion to approve the Gibson County amended EDIT Plan for 2015-2016, seconded by Councilman Ankenbrand. Motion carried 6-0.
- EMA – Reimbursable Foundation Grant #8110 – EMA Director Terry Hedges informed the Council of an EMPG Grant that will be awarded to the County for partial reimbursement of the EMA Director and Deputy Director's salaries. Also there may be a \$4,000 reimbursable Foundation Grant awarded to the County.
- An HMEP Reimbursable Grant # 8301 for Training in the amount of \$4,928 and another HMEP Grant #8302 for Local Planning in the amount of \$8500 totaling \$13,428 has already been awarded to the County.
- Councilman McConnell informed everyone that the GCARC has applied for two new vans. He just let everyone know that this organization has helped many Gibson County residents.
- Councilman McConnell requested that someone look into the companies that the County has given abatements to, to see if all requirements are being met.


