


- a. The fall tax settlement money had been received and credited to each ditch account.
- b. Maintenance needs to be performed on the top end of Upper Pigeon Creek/bottom end of the Toelle Drain. Larry Georges was contacted prior to the crops being harvested to perform this maintenance. The beans have been harvested and it can now be worked on.
- c. The Surveyor's Office is looking into the cost of contracting a company to spray one ditch next year to see how effective it would be. A contract would need to be drawn up and an attorney would need to review it before anything would be considered.
- d. Surveyor Stevenson spoke with David Knight of the DNR and told him of the signed contract with Williams Mapping for the two foot contours and that we would like this data used in creating the new FIRM Panel maps. Mr. Knight stated that since we are investing into getting this type of data, there could possibly be more projects done in the county.
- e. There was a flooding problem after one inch of rain near the Schwiersh property on 550 East. The possibility of Warrick County having obstructions was suggested but photos of the area were just taken by Terry Hedges and things look good. Surveyor Stevenson stated he believed that the increased amount of run off is causing some of this and again offered the idea of some type of drainage ordinance within the county requiring retention ponds if "X" amount of acres are developed.

With there being no other business, Bob Townsend made a motion to adjourn. Don Whitehead seconded the motion and the meeting was adjourned.


