

MINUTES OF THE JANUARY 15, 2008 DRAINAGE BOARD MEETING

The Gibson County Drainage Board met in regular session on Tuesday, January 15, 2008 at 1:15 p.m. Members present were N. Sherrell Marginet, Don Whitehead and Bob Townsend. Also present were Michael Stevenson, Candace Corn, and Orville Byrns.

I. MINUTES

- a. Minutes of the last meeting were read. Bob Townsend made a motion that the minutes be approved. Don Whitehead seconded the motion and the minutes were unanimously approved.

- a. The Surveyor's Office received a final set of plans from Gibson Water (for Gibson County Coal) for water lines crossing the Little Lillard Ditch. The drawings show the line being moved from the north side of the road to the south side of the road and there will only be one crossing of the regulated drain. The Gibson County Ordinance to Cross a Regulated Drain has been incorporated into the drawing and it appears they are following the ordinance. Don Whitehead made a motion to accept the drawings and the crossing of the Little Lillard. Bob Townsend seconded the motion and the motion was unanimously approved.

V. OLD BUSINESS



Commissioner Whitehead stated he felt we should work on the subdivision control ordinance first.
b. There was no new information on the subdivision control ordinance.


VI. NEW BUSINESS
