

VI. DISCUSSION


- a. Georges Excavating has completed maintenance on Stunkel Main near the old Nordhorn Bridge. The County Highway Department had the abutments removed and Georges Excavating shaped the corner of the bank to help relieve the pressure on the opposite bank. The dirt removed was used to fill in a washout within the right-of-way.
- b. Grubb Excavating has completed maintenance on the Toelle Ditch. Brush and small saplings were removed from the right-of-way from Seedtick Road to a point approximately 500 feet north of Heights Chapel Road. The portion of the ditch adjacent to Randy Scales' property is inaccessible and therefore it was not worked on for this project. Structures and other items in the right-of-way of the ditch prevented access to this area.
- c. Mark Naas has started work on the Trippet Ditch. Maple sprouts are being removed and the slope is being pulled back to 2:1 from the river to the bridge over Trippet Road.
- d. IDEM has dissolved their office of enforcement.
- e. Jeff Rode with Rode & Sons Excavating contacted the Surveyor's Office to make an appointment to meet with Surveyor Stevenson at the location on the Lillard where pipes are being replaced. Mr. Rode stated he hoped to begin work on December 18th.

With there being no other business, Bob Townsend made a motion to adjourn. Don Whitehead seconded the motion and the meeting was adjourned.


Note: During informal conversation after the meeting it was suggested that the Lillard Ditch be the second ditch to go through the reassessing process (after the Metz Ditch).




